Stage II Diagnostic Imaging Accreditation Scheme

The Department of Health and Ageing (DoHA) has determined that the modalities listed in the table below must be accredited under the Diagnostic Imaging Scheme Stage II.

A diagnostic imaging modality is one of the following groups of diagnostic imaging procedures:

Modality	Relevant items in the diagnostic imaging services table	Medicare Code
Ultrasound	All items in <u>Group I1.</u>	ULT
Computed Tomography	All items in <u>Group I2.</u>	CTG
Diagnostic Radiology including General Radiology (X-ray), Mammography, Angiography, Fluoroscopy and Orthopantomography (OPG)	All items in <u>Group I3.</u>	RAD
Nuclear Medicine Imaging	All items in <u>Group I4.</u>	NME
Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI)	All items in <u>Group I5.</u>	MRI
